## Criteria

### Junior and Club Person of the Year:

These are major awards. The awards recognise a club person/s who go above what is expected to support the club and provide a greater football experience for our Junior members and Senior Members. The recipient should be someone who gives their time to the club without expectation of compensation or financial reward. They are a positive presence at the club who represent us well in the football community and their commitment and purpose as a club member is of great benefit to our members.

This person does not need to be a committee member. It can be a Parent, a Player, a Coach, a Manager or any other member.

Other qualities should include:

- Always a team worker.
- Regular volunteer (Game Days, Six a side, Committee support, Team support).
- Represents the Club in a positive light.
- Respectful of officials, opponents, and other supporters.
- Maintains positive relationships with other club members and committee.

### Coach of the year (All Awards):

Suggestions of qualities/details to include in nomination:

- Coaching ability and knowledge of the game
- Individual athlete development and support
- Team development and improvement
- Leadership and dedication
- Sportsmanship and fair play
- Fostering a positive playing environment
- Respect for officials, opponents, and supporters



### Player of the Year (All Awards):

Any player from any Junior Competitive team, Youth team or Senior team can be nominated (for the appropriate age award). Suggested criteria for the nomination are:

- Playing Ability
- Playing achievements this season (representative teams, TSP, School football)
- Positive influence/role model in their team/plays for other teams when asked (team player)
- Coachable
- Sportsmanship
- Strives to always represent the club positively
- Respectful of officials / opponents and supporters
- Contributes to other club activities (volunteers/coaches/manages a team/helps a side/a referee) an advantage but not a necessity
- **For extra consideration for Senior players.** The Senior Club Player of the Year should possess a lot of the above characteristics and do more than is expected than just being a player in a team. Be a great role model and encourage and promote a positive footballing environment for Youth players entering Senior football. (An advantage but not a necessity.)

### Most Consistent Team (Junior Competitive):

Points to consider:

- Team Performance throughout the season.
- Individual Player Performance, behaviour and Development
- Sportsmanship and fair play. Towards the opponents.
- Respect for officials and spectators.
- Team commitment, organisation and dedication to football.
